

Tuition to attend CWRU for MS in Nutrition or Master's in Public Health (MPH)

For most students, the MS in Nutrition requires a minimum of 30 credit hours to complete and the MPH requires a minimum of 42 credits. For 2017-2018, the cost of graduate tuition at CWRU will be \$1827/credit.

For those interested in the **3+2 with MS in Nutrition**, it is estimated that they will need to complete 4 semesters of 9 credits to meet program requirements.

$$32 \times \$1827 = \mathbf{\$58,464}$$

For students interested in the **1+1 program with the MS in Nutrition**, it is estimated that they will need to complete a total of 24 credits over 1 year to complete program requirements.

$$24 \times \$1827 = \mathbf{\$43,848}$$

For students interested in the **3+2 program with the MPH**, it is estimated that they will need to complete 42 credits over 4 semesters.

$$42 \times \$1827 = \mathbf{\$76,734}$$

For students interested in the **1+1.5 program with the MPH**, it is estimated that they will need to complete 36 credits over 3 semesters.

$$36 \times \$1827 = \mathbf{\$65,772}$$

Please note that this does not include:

- Housing
- Living expenses
- Travel to and from CWRU
- Health insurance (can be optionally purchased for around \$1000/semester if not covered via personal plan)
- Visa costs
- Activity fee (\$17/semester)

Please note that all costs listed above are given in US dollars.
